

Adult Program: Designed for adults and/or children 13 years of age or older*. The course offerings in this program will focus on different aspects of kayaking. Some sessions will be on-water; others will be held on land.

Youth Program: Designed for youth 7-12 years of age*. This program combines kayaking classes with other camp activities designed to keep youth active during the adult program hours.

**All children under the age of 18 must have a registered adult on the grounds at all times in order to participate in symposium activities.*
